Knowing when to make final choices for your beloved pet is difficult. So many factors play a role that it can be overwhelming to evaluate our pet's overall well-being. Using this guide may help. By using specific parameters, you can form an impression daily. Then tracking these daily evaluations, you can better see trends that may make it just a little easier to decide what to do. Keep in mind, a negative trend does not always mean euthanasia! Often, we here at Cinder Rock Veterinary Clinic can recommend interventions that can help improve quality of life. Then, when the time comes, we will continue to treat your pet with compassionate care and love.

As you assess your pet, use \bigcirc for a good day, \bigcirc for a so-so day, and \bigcirc for a not so good day.

If you prefer, you can also use numbers: 2 for a good day, 1 for a so-so day, and 0 for a not so good day.

There are 2 blank columns for parameters specific to your pet.
