## **Advanced Dental Procedures and Oral Surgery**

Dental disease, untreated or treated incorrectly, can rob your pet of a comfortable, happy life. This is why it is so important that they receive regular home dental care, along with high quality medical attention when needed. Though our emphasis is on prevention of dental disease (see Preventative Dental Home Care for Your Pet), treatment and oral surgery under general anesthesia is sometimes necessary. In such cases your pet will receive the following from Cinder Rock Veterinary Clinic:

- 1. Pre-anesthetic exam and a thorough oral exam under anesthesia
- 2. Pre-operative pain medication
- 3. General anesthesia (see anesthetic information)
- 4. Dental radiographs of every tooth
- 5. Detailed dental medical records and periodontal charting
- 6. Oral nerve blocks for extractions
- 7. Post extraction radiographs
- 8. Sterile surgical tools for each patient
- 9. Ultrasonic cleaning and polishing
- 10. Doctors, technicians and assistants with advanced dental education and training
- 11. State-of-the-art dental and surgical equipment
- 12. Post procedure pain medications when indicated
- 13. Detailed written after care instructions with preventative care plan
- 14. Complimentary appointment for preventative care training with a technician
- 15. Doctor on call to answer after-hours questions
- 16. Progress exam with the doctor if needed

Preventing any disease, including dental disease, is always preferred. The benefits of maintaining your pet's oral health is well documented. There can also be significant costs if dental disease develops and oral surgery becomes necessary.
